HELP BUILD THE PIKE ANIMAL SHELTER!

Pike County is home to hundreds, perhaps thousands, of stray dogs and cats. Many of these animals were once domesticated or are the offspring of domesticated animals. Most of these animals are hungry, injured or desperate, and all are in need.

The Troy Animal Shelter Coalition is a non-profit, 501(c)3 organization formed in the fall of 2006 by volunteers with backgrounds in veterinary care, law, nonprofit management and volunteer organizations.

The goal is to see that our community has a quality, accessible animal shelter that is a pillar in all animal welfare efforts and that adds value to the quality of life in our community.

WHY DO EACH OF US NEED TO RAISE FUNDS?

WHAT IS THE TASC AND HOW IS IT RELATED TO THE PIKE ANIMAL SHELTER?

The Troy Animal Shelter Coalition manages the Pike Animal Shelter Fund. Contributions to the Fund are tax deductible.

HOW WILL THE MONEY BE USED?

To build a shelter to serve our community. In doing this, funds raised also help with of adoptions and other animal welfare programs.

To ensure that funds raised benefit the animals, the Pike Animal Shelter Fund/TASC has a conflict of interest policy to prevent any individual from gaining financially, professionally or politically through association with the shelter. The Pike Animal Shelter Fund/TASC is committed to sound financial management, has engaged the services of area bankers for advice and publishes its treasurer's report. Tax returns are available for review upon request.

WHAT ABOUT RECOGNITION FOR FUNDRAISERS?

Fundraisers are recognized in many ways including sponsorships, fundraising awards, publicity for fundraising events, and the annual Pike Animal Shelter Fur Fest.

HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Form a team or just plan to work individually. Check out the fund raiser ideas that follow!
2. Use the Registration Form to register.
 - Although registration is not necessary, your registration helps the Pike Animal Shelter volunteers publicize your fundraiser, track your donations and consider you for fundraising awards.
3. Collect money in cash or check. Make sure checks are payable to “Pike Animal Shelter.”
4. Use the Deposit Form to make deposits as you go (this ensures that funds you collect are quickly processed and correctly credited).
 - You may make deposits at any time at the main office of Troy Bank and Trust. For more deposit information, call 808-8898.

MANAGING YOUR EXPENSES

If you plan to deduct your expenses from the total you raise, please do so prior to making your deposits. The Shelter Fund cannot reimburse you.
